ITEM 3 - PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

3. The Corps Treasurer has authorised the renewal of the Corps Insurance Policy through Wilson's, our previous insurer. The new policy became effective on 23rd October 2009. Branches and groups, or the nominated event organiser, should to check with the insurer that the current public liability cover extends to events that they may decide to organise.

Historian Hugh Sebag-Montefiore is looking for accounts written or recorded by soldiers who served in the Royal Engineers, including in tunnelling companies, or in any other regiment, during the July-November 1916 battle of the Somme. This is in connection with a book on the fighting on the Somme commissioned by Penguin which he is researching. The book will focus on the capture or attempted capture of the chain of villages and strongpoints which had to be overcome if the German line was to be broken and will include action taken by the 174th, 178th, 179th, 183rd, 252nd Tunnelling Companies when digging tunnels and exploding mines under German lines in order to assist the infantry's advances.
