ITEM 2 - AGM NOTIFICATION

2. This year the Annual General Meeting of the Association is to be held at the Victory Services Club, 63/79 Seymour Street, London W2 2HF on Saturday 9th October 2010, commencing at 1600 hours.

3. The attention of Groups and Branches is drawn to Rules 11.01 to 11.40, which govern the procedure at the Annual General Meeting.

4. The REA Form for notifying the names and addresses of Branch Delegates and details of travel expenses claimed will be issued with the next HQ Circular.

ITEM 3 – ANNUAL DINNER

5. This year the Annual Dinner of the Association is to be held at the Victory Services Club, 63/79 Seymour Street, London W2 2HF on Saturday 9th October 2010, following the Annual General Meeting. Reception will be at 1800 hours for 1830 hours with the bar opening at 1730 hours. Branches and members are encouraged to support this very enjoyable annual event.

6. Dress for gentlemen will be lounge suits or blazer and flannels with Corps tie; ladies should dress appropriately.

7. In recent years it has been increasingly difficult to maintain the ticket price which has been held since 2000 at £18. Reluctantly HQ REA finds it necessary to raise the ticket price to £20. This still represents extremely good value for a 4 course meal at a top quality venue in Central London.

8. An application form for tickets will be issued with the next HQ Circular. Closing date for bookings will be 23 September 2010.

ITEM 4 – SAPPER SUNDAY, THE ROYAL HOSPITAL CHELSEA

9. SAPPER SUNDAY will take place on Sunday 10th October 2010 at The Royal Hospital Chelsea. This is the day after the REA AGM and Annual Dinner and a good turnout from REA Members in London and from around the country is expected. Members are encouraged to attend this event, meet the RE In-Pensioners and swap stories over a few pints. Branches are requested to give this event the very widest publicity. The event in 2009 was the best attendance for years; as a result, the catering facilities of the Royal Hospital were severely stretched. This year, catering must be limited to 50, and available only to those in possession of an "REA Curry Pass". So if you are attending Sapper Sunday and would like a curry, please advise the Deputy Controller REA so that he can issue tickets for catering. Branches attending Sapper Sunday as a branch event are most welcome, but those attending the Annual Dinner and Sapper Sunday will be given priority for "REA Curry Passes".

ITEM 5 - REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY

10. Remembrance Sunday will be on Sunday 14th November 2010. Branches requiring tickets for the Remembrance Sunday Parade at the Cenotaph, Whitehall, London, are to apply, in writing, to HQ REA stating the number of tickets required.

11. The Royal British Legion has requested that bids are only made through Regimental Association Headquarters and not direct to them. Bids are requested by **30th July 2010** to enable a consolidated bid to be submitted during August.

ITEM 6 – NATIONAL STANDARD BEARERS COMPETITION

12. The National Standard Bearers' Competition is to be held at Brompton Barracks, Chatham, during the Veterans/Corps Memorial Weekend as part of the main IRSME event on Saturday 18th September 2010. The exact timings are not yet known.

13. All Groups are encouraged to enter the competition, particularly as entrants for the competition may claim travelling and reasonable overnight expenses.

14. Groups and Branches are reminded that:

- a. Competitors must be REA members and members of the REA branch for which they carry the Standard.
- b. Participation is limited to winners of the Group Competition or person nominated by the Group Director where no competition takes place.
- c. Only one Standard Bearer from each group can take part in the National Competition.
- d. The current National Standard Bearer does not get automatic entry to the National Competition. The criteria at 14.b above apply.

ITEM 7 – VETERANS’ WEEKENDS

15. The Veterans’ Weekend at Minley is to be held over the weekend 18 - 20 June 2010.

16. The Veterans’ Weekend at Chatham is to be held over the weekend 17 – 19 September 2010.

ITEM 9 - GROUP AND BRANCH OFFICIALS CONTACT LIST


